

## Portage County Literacy Council – Job Description

**Position:** Small Group Lead – Currently Online

**Description:** The small group lead will plan and lead English classes (currently online) for adults who are learning English. Each class will average 3-5 adult learners and are often multi-level (typically beginning to intermediate level learners). The emphasis is on conversation, with some reading, writing, and civics instruction. The curriculum will emphasize mini-presentations that integrate visuals, videos, and/or real life props; modeling; and peer-to-peer interaction and student talk time.

Developing topic-based lesson plans for interactive classes that emphasize conversation Working with adult learners in a small group setting Tracking learner hours and progress

Maintaining regular communication with the Co-Directors

## **Qualifications:**

- Demonstrated experience teaching adult English language learners
- Ability to create engaging lesson plans
- Ability to maintain a weekly schedule
- Self-motivated and creative
- Good communication skills
- Respect for adults of different cultural and socioeconomic backgrounds
- Organized and ability to complete paperwork accurately
- Ability to be flexible and respond to changing situations
- Completion of ESL minor or other ESL certification
- Knowledge of other languages and/or cultures (preferred)

**Hours:** 3 hours week (1 hour prep and 2 hours class)
